- 2. That it is necessary and a public purpose to acquire the property interests depicted on the

Plat attached hereto as Exhibit A, in order to accomplish the improvement of a portion of CTH S.

3. That the required property interests shall be acquired in the name of Kenosha County and, upon acquisition, shall be used for the improvement of CTH S.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Executive, County Clerk, Highway Commissioner and others designated by the administration are authorized to execute any and all contracts, agreements, deeds or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
