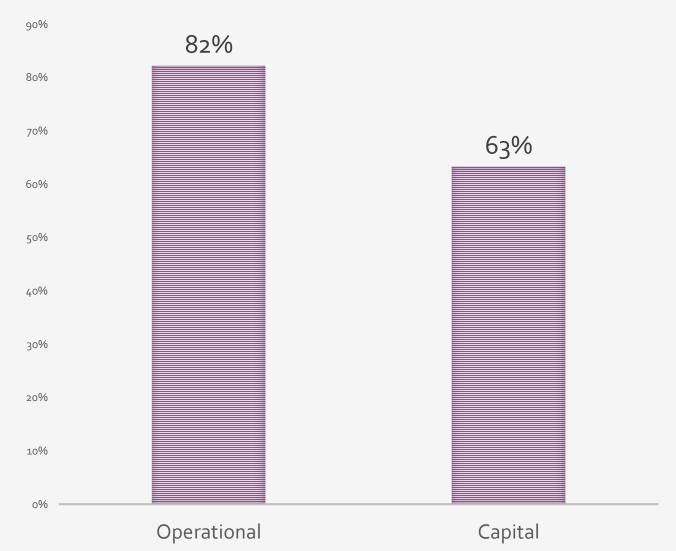

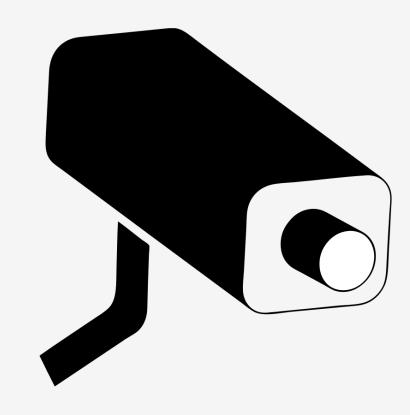

#### • Security Camera System

- IT created a consolidated system; reducing total cost of ownership while improving features and functions
- More than 600 cameras across County Buildings
- Target to record a minimum of 131 days
- Single system replaced 7+ disparate systems
- High quality digital recordings replaced low-grade analog

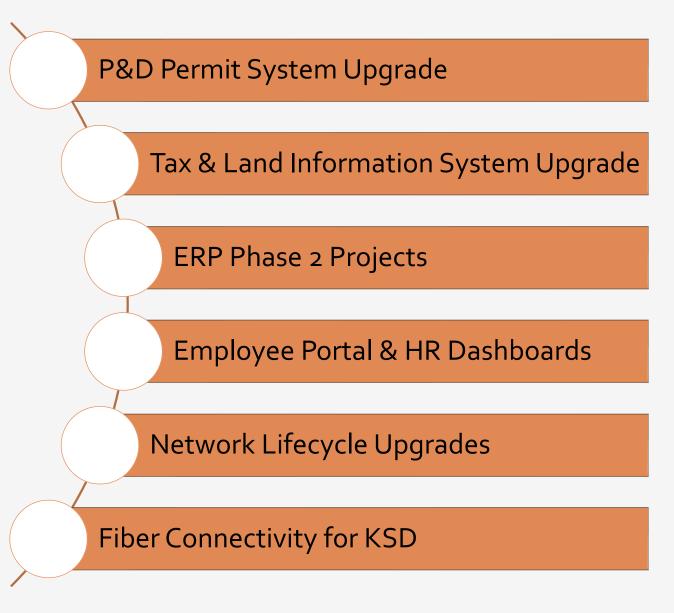

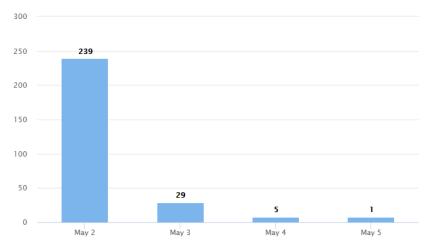

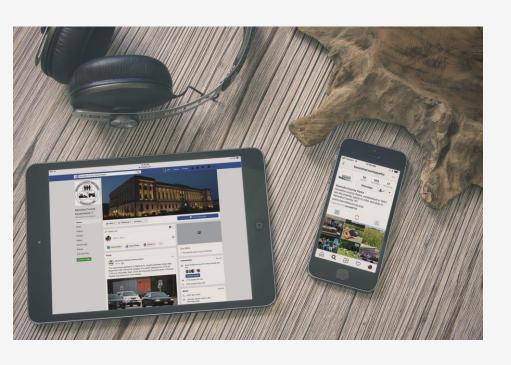
# User Awareness and Training Campaign
