Kenosha County Ordinance, Section 7.025 on <u>TRAFFIC CONTROLS</u> is hereby amended by creating Section (2) (gg) as follows:

(gg) Four-Way Stop on intersection of County Trunk Highway "EA" and County Trunk Highway "A". Traffic from all directions shall stop at the intersection of C.T.H. "EA" and C.T.H. "A", and a Stop sign shall be placed at each corner of the intersection. This intersection is located in said Kenosha County, Wisconsin in the Village of Somers.
