4. Discussion of Mental Health Services in Kenosha

John Jansen laid out the plan for this presentation and introduced everyone who would be presenting. Handouts were distributed.

Jim Truchan stated that we serve about 3,100 people a year. At any one time, we have 300 people mandated under Chapter 51 care. Because people have BadgerCare now, St. Luke's Hospital is usually full, so we have to send people to the mental health institutes. 79 people were placed in residential care 14 years ago. We now have 51 placed. LaVerne Jaros acknowledged the shortage of psychiatrists and counselors. Chris Hribal spoke about the children's services, saying that CCS has been around for a long time. Jack Rose added that we have a really outstanding CCS program.

Byron Wright gave his presentation, informing everyone that there should be "1" psychiatrist for every 10,000 people in a county. We have "6". We are "10" short. Jack Rose stated that mental illness touches 1 in 4 of us. When asked what could be done to improve services, Jack Rose said he would like to see First Step Services become a center like Bridges, as this is a population not being served.

Jeff Gentz said he would like to see a community-based committee (regional planning committee) to work with everyone here to address these problems presented. LaVerne Jaros will take charge of this task.
