CIRCUMSTANCES OF EVENT

- 1. Sunny T. Chong is an adult resident of the City and County of Racine, State of Wisconsin, whose current address is 6111 Douglas Avenue, Racine, Wisconsin 53402.
 - 2. Date and time of incident: January 6, 2017 at 6:38 a.m.
 - 3. Location of incident: STH 158/52nd Street, at or about the intersection with 17th Avenue, in the City and County of Kenosha, State of Wisconsin.
- 4. Circumstances of incident: Claimant, Sunny T. Chong, on the date and time indicated, was traveling east bound in the curb lane in the 1700 block of STH 158/52nd Street. Kenosha County Sheriff Deputy, Adam R.
