WHEREAS, in order to improve the safety and security of the detention staff and the inmate/detainee population, it is the desire of the Sheriff to purchase and install a full body security scanning system in the admission and release area of the PreTrial facility, and

WHEREAS, the cost of this system is \$120,000 and the funding will be provided by the proceeds earned through the Sheriff's Department Inmate Commissary program, and

WHEREAS, the desired product is the **SOTER RS Full Body Security Scanning System** manufactured by OD Security North America which is the sole licensed manufacturer and distributer of this model and the only vendor who manufactures like systems in the United States, and

WHEREAS, this product is found to best fit the needs of correctional environments and can be customized to fit the environment where it will be installed providing the smallest footprint compared to other scanning systems and this model has the smallest radiation footprint of other like products on the market, and

WHEREAS, County Municipal Ordinance Chapter 3, 3.11 (4)(a) Purchasing Policy directs that purchases exceeding \$10,000 must be procured through a competitive bidding process unless, by resolution passed by County Board, waives the competitive bid process, and

WHEREAS, a Request for Sole Source Justification document had drafted and submitted for review and approval by the County Purchasing Director and is made part of this Resolution justifying the request to Sole Source the vendor, OD Security North America, and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff requests approval to suspend the competitive bid process and authorize the purchase of the full body security scanning system from OD Security North America.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Kenosha County Board, approve the increase in expenditure and revenue of \$120,000 in order to afford the scanning device. The budget modification form has also been incorporated herein by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, at year end, Administration will match actual expenditures with funding to account for other expenditures associated with this purchase plan, such as, but not limited to, price changes, shipping and handling costs, which may require additional non-levy funds to be allocated.

-Price, other system that we inquired about is priced at \$243,000 starting. (Canon RadPRO SecurPASS) -Equipment is manufactured and installed by OD Security North America not contracted out.
4. What steps were taken to verify that these features are not available elsewhere? X Other brands/manufacturers were examined (please list phone numbers and names, and explain why thes were not suitable).
RadPRO SecurPASS Full Body Security Screening System, 561-573-3393, Dennis Wolfe, Rep for Canon, was slow in response, did not get back to me for a demo or a sales pitch. Site visit to Brevard County Florida who owns two, the footprint would necessitate a larger space than KSD has room for. The price paid by Brevard was \$243,000 per unit. That number was verified as the starting point with Canon. 2 year warranty. This unit is manufactured overseas and managed by the reps out of Florida and Georgia.


