WHEREAS, in 2016, Kenosha County Parks Division constructed a parkway, parking lots and storm water retention basins within KD Park; and

WHEREAS, these improvements were part of the overall master plan to improve KD Park; and

WHEREAS, the overall master plan to KD Park includes restoring natural areas to provide recreational amenities and educational features to the residents of Kenosha County; and

WHEREAS, WDNR Urban Forestry grant funding is available to fund the development of a savanna restoration plan in KD Park; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of the project shall not exceed \$25,000, of which one half or \$12,500 will be Kenosha County match; and

WHEREAS, Kenosha County receives the grant, the source of the County match shall be appropriated within the approved County budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Kenosha County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Parks to act on its behalf to submit an application to the WDNR for an Urban Forestry grant, sign documents and take necessary action to undertake, direct and complete the approved project.
