Approval of the Minutes from August 7, 2019:

Resolutions from the Kenosha County Sheriff's Department:

1) Resolution to Approve the Appointment of Rick Dodge to Serve as a Member of the Kenosha County Local Emergency Planning Committee

Motion by: Wamboldt *Seconded by:* Celebre *Approved:* unanimously 6:33 Lt. Staples advised that Mr. Dodge has been a member of this committee for several

years and this reappointment would be for an additional 3-year term. Dodge's attendance record has included only 2 excused absences. Mr. Dodge explained that he enjoys being on this committee.

2) FY2019 Law Enforcement Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Award

Motion by: Rodriguez Seconded by: Yuhas Approved: unanimously 6:36 Chief Deputy Levin explained that the grant is an annual one that is offered to the City of Kenosha and shared with Kenosha County. The amount of the grant amount is \$33,660.00. There is a 60/40 split, giving the county \$13,464.00. This money is awarded for equipment and will be used to purchase AEDs. Supv. Wamboldt inquired as to why the split was 60/40 and Levin explained that the city processes all the paperwork. Levin stated that the new AEDs will likely be used in squads. Chairman Frederick requested to know the number of AEDs this grant would purchase.

Discussion on Training Deputies Receive for Working with Sexual Assault Victims:

6:38 Sgt. Merlin explained that deputies receive scenario-based training at the academy, and then come back to the department and receive an additional 4 step field training program. Sensitive Crimes Detectives receive additional specialized training. Merlin provided literature to the Supervisors describing training for different crimes. He went on to explain that typically specific deputies are better fit to respond to sensitive crimes, they too receive additional training. Merlin advised that all cases are different, and each case is handled individually.

Discussion Regarding Date and Time for October 2019 Budget Meeting:
