3. Health: Resolution to Reorganize the Public Health Laboratory

Bob Riedl said that due to the retirement of the current Laboratory Director, the Health lab needs to be reorganized to meet federal requirements. The current Medical Examiner will serve as Laboratory Director and oversee the clinical lab testing only. She is well qualified and will still continue to be the Medical Examiner.

Frank Matteo added that the current Forensic Chemist would assume additional responsibilities and would receive a non-competitive promotion. A second lab technologist would also be hired. This reorganization would increase the lab staff and save \$5,500 in levy-funded costs.
