Environmental

They have completed their DNR contract (sampled 167 public wells) along with their Septic Holding Tank Inventory (450).

HUD

We are initiating a new grant cycle 2017–2020. Late start for this grant because we were closing out the previous grant.

Clinical Services

There has been an increased number of unvaccinated children residing in the county.

Population Health

Narcan trainings continue. Our MAT Program (Medication Assisted Treatment) has 43 clients receiving injections.

KLIHF (Kenosha Lifecourse Initiative)

233 essays were submitted to the questions "What Is a Healthy Community to You"? Four $4^{th} - 8^{th}$ grade students were selected from four different schools. They received an award and were featured in an article in the Kenosha News.

Staffing

Currently have 2 open positions: a Public Health Tech and a School Nurse.
