Decker. On a roll call vote, motion failed 8-13-1. Supervisors Grady, Thomas, Stock, Stocker, Geertsen, Bashaw, Poole, and Vice Chair Decker voting AYE. Supervisors Rose, Gentz, Belsky, Kubicki, Gaschke, Rodriguez, O'Day, Berg, Franco, Yuhas, Wamboldt, Karow, and Chairman Nudo voting NAY.

Supervisor Nordigian abstaining.

After some discussion, Supervisor Berg made a motion to "Call the Question". It was seconded by Supervisor Rose. On a roll call vote, motion failed 12-9-1.

Supervisors Grady, Rose, Belsky, Kubicki, O'Day, Berg, Yuhas, Wamboldt, Bashaw, Poole, Karow, and Chairman Nudo voting AYE.

Supervisors Gentz, Thomas, Gaschke, Rodriguez, Stock, Franco, Stocker, Geertsen, and Vice Chair Decker voting NAY.

Supervisor Nordigian abstaining.

After some discussion, Supervisor Rose made a motion to "Call the Question". It was seconded by Supervisor Kubicki. On a roll call vote, motion passes 15-6-1. Supervisors Grady, Rose, Gentz, Belsky, Kubicki, O'Day, Berg, Franco, Stocker, Wamboldt, Bashaw, Poole, Karow, Vice Chair Decker, and Chairman Nudo voting AYE. Supervisors Thomas, Gaschke, Rodriguez, Stock, Geertsen, and Yuhas voting NAY. Supervisor Nordigian abstained.

On a roll call vote, Resolution 102 failed 5-16-1. Supervisors Grady, Stocker, Geertsen, Poole, and Vice Chair Decker voting AYE. Supervisors Rose, Gentz, Belsky, Thomas, Kubicki, Gaschke, Rodriguez, O'Day, Berg, Stock, Franco, Yuhas, Wamboldt, Bashaw, Karow, and Chairman Nudo voting NAY. Supervisor Nordigian abstained.
