Environmental Highlights – Mark Melotik	<p>Mark distributed 2 handouts. This past year there has been a change to the State Swimming Pool Code. The Health Department has revised our Chapter 16 codes to be more in line with the State. Recently held a training seminar at the Rec Plex in Pleasant Prairie with over 67 attendees (including Waukesha County) to go over new swimming pool codes. Kenosha County licenses 70 pools and inspects them annually.</p> <p>Some lesser-known services that our Environmental Health section provides:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• There are over 800 gas pumps in the city of Kenosha that are checked annually• Kenosha County licenses 136 mobile home parks (including hotels, motels, tourist rooming houses)• We sample 143 public wells and educate on safe water• Package checking – state requires us to check specific stores• Member of a State Field Team for radiation• Have over 800 restaurants/retail food establishments that we license• Have a new program for lead testing in daycares• Have a HUD grant to remediate lead from older homes in Kenosha/Racine <p>We would like to focus more on all the things the Health Department does vs giving immunizations.
