- Hallway Happy Hour is served from a hospitality cart with mobile music.

During this Easter season, it has been important to ensure the spiritual needs of our residents are met, so we have been offering in-room Stations of the Cross and daily televised worship services, as well as spiritual communion.

In addition to all these activities, we have been busy connecting residents to family via FaceTime and Skype, something that has also kept me in contact with my parents — we are so grateful for technology!
