

WANT FASTER INTERNET?

**Help Kenosha County attract
broadband investment!**

Increasingly, Kenosha County residents' daily lives are online - for work, school and entertainment. This trend was accelerated by the COVID-19 pandemic, putting more pressure on Kenosha's broadband infrastructure. Residents need, and deserve, quick and efficient access to the internet.

Through the end of 2022, we have a unique opportunity to help ensure fast, affordable internet access for all just by taking a brief online speed test. The test is quick, easy and will take less than a minute to complete.

If enough residents complete the speed test by the end of the year, internet service providers in Kenosha County may be eligible to receive state and federal grants to improve broadband infrastructure, meaning residents could have faster internet sooner.

Take The Speed Test

Complete the speed test at home or at your business. Do not use your cellular connection or hotspot.



- 1** Visit kenoshacounty.org/quickconnect or scan the QR code. Ensure you are using wifi, not a cellular connection or hotspot.
- 2** Enter your **residential or business address**
- 3** Click **"Let's Do It"** and complete the speed test

Once you complete the test, you will be able to determine if your internet speed is within FCC standards (25 Mbps download and 3 Mbps upload). If internet speeds are below the FCC standard, internet service providers who serve Kenosha County may qualify for state and/or federal grants.
