Project HISTORY

The Kenosha County Center Prairie was established in 2016. Restoration of the tallgrass prairie provides a safe habitat for local bird and insect species while providing a free recreational and educational amenity for the Kenosha County Community.

The Arboretum was established in 2020 highlighting the diversity of tree species in our region. Currently there are 94 trees under various families (24) and genus (45) around the one-mile paved walking trail around the prairie.



With easy access from the northeast corner of the parking lot on the west side of the building, visitors to the arboretum can take a guided tour via this brochure. The trees are also marked with placards that include a QR code, linking smartphone users to more information about them on the Extension website.


