COUNTY HIGHWAY K TO RESUME FOR FINAL WORK

Greetings from Kenosha County and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT). The project team is scheduled to resume work on County Highway K (60th Street) by the Canadian Pacific Railroad (CPRR).

The following work is scheduled to resume in mid-June and complete in mid-summer:

- Railroad track replacement by CPRR
- Grading, pavement, and curb and gutter at CPRR
- Railroad signal and gate replacement by CPRR
- Paving the multi-use path and sidewalk at CPRR

Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.

Detour Route

The construction will close a portion of County
Highway K between 88th Avenue and the Union
Pacific Railroad. Motorists will need to use
WIS 31 (Green Bay Road), WIS 158 (52nd Street)
and 88th Avenue to navigate the closure.

Local access will be maintained from 88th to 82nd and from Green Bay Road to 77th.
