

## COUNTY HIGHWAY K TO RESUME FOR FINAL WORK

Greetings from Kenosha County and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT). The project team is scheduled to resume work on County Highway K (60th Street) by the Canadian Pacific Railroad (CPRR).

**The following work is scheduled to resume in mid-June and complete in mid-summer:**

- Railroad track replacement by CPRR
- Grading, pavement, and curb and gutter at CPRR
- Railroad signal and gate replacement by CPRR
- Paving the multi-use path and sidewalk at CPRR

*Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.*

### Detour Route

- The construction will close a portion of County Highway K between 88th Avenue and the Union Pacific Railroad. Motorists will need to use WIS 31 (Green Bay Road), WIS 158 (52nd Street) and 88th Avenue to navigate the closure.

*Local access will be maintained from 88th to 82nd and from Green Bay Road to 77th.*
