## Fentanyl is Everywhere

**IN CASE OF EMERGENCY OR SUSPECTED OVERDOSE – CALL 911** 

### Deadly Opioid is being found in counterfeit pills and illegal drugs.

- Local law enforcement has seized and tested fake prescriptions and counterfeit pills of all types; some have tested positive for fentanyl.
- Illegal drugs such as cocaine and marijuana have also tested positive for fentanyl.

## What Does An OVERDOSE LOOK LIKE?



**BREATHING** – the person is not breathing or is breathing very slowly.

**LIPS** – Lips and fingertips turn blue.

**UNRESPONSIVE** – No response when you yell the person's name or rub middle of chest hard.

**EYES** – Center part of eyes (pupils) are very small, also known as pinpoint pupils.
