Referendum Election Details

At an election to be held in the School District Number 1, Town of Brighton on April 2, 2024, the following proposed Revenue Limit Resolution of the School Board will be submitted to a vote of the people:

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGET TO EXCEED REVENUE LIMIT FOR FOUR YEARS FOR NON-RECURRING PURPOSES

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of the School District Number 1, Town of Brighton, Kenosha and Racine Counties, Wisconsin that the revenues included in the School District budget be authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$200,000 for the 2024-2025 school year, by \$225,000 for the 2025-2026 school year, by \$250,000 for the 2026-2027 school year and by \$275,000 for the 2027-2028 school year, for non-recurring purposes consisting of operational expenses and maintaining educational programming.

Ballot Text

The question will appear on the ballot as follows:

"Shall the School District Number 1, Town of Brighton, Kenosha and Racine Counties, Wisconsin be authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$200,000 for the 2024-2025 school year, by \$225,000 for the 2025-2026 school year, by \$250,000 for the 2026-2027 school year and by \$275,000 for the 2027-2028 school year, for non-recurring purposes consisting of operational expenses and maintaining educational programming?"

Explanation

The referendum election ballot will ask District electors to vote "yes" or "no" on the referendum election question as set forth above.

A "yes" vote on the question is a vote to authorize the School District Number 1, Town of Brighton budget to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$200,000 for the 2024-2025 school year, by \$225,000 for the 2025-2026 school year, by \$250,000 for the 2026-2027 school year and by \$275,000 for the 2027-2028 school year, for non-recurring purposes consisting of operational expenses and maintaining educational programming.

A "no" vote on the question is a vote to deny the School District Number 1, Town of Brighton the authority to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$200,000 for the 2024-2025 school year, by \$225,000 for the 2025-2026 school year, by \$250,000 for the 2026-2027 school year and by \$275,000 for the 2027-2028 school year, for non-recurring purposes consisting of operational expenses and maintaining educational programming.

In the event a majority of the electors voting on the question vote "yes", the District will be authorized to exceed the revenue limit specified in Section 121.91, Wisconsin Statutes, by \$200,000 for the 2024-2025 school year, by \$225,000 for the 2025-2026 school year, by \$250,000 for the 2026-2027 school year and by \$275,000 for the 2027-2028 school year, for non-recurring purposes consisting of operational expenses and maintaining educational programming; if a majority vote "no" on the question set forth above, the District will not be so authorized.
