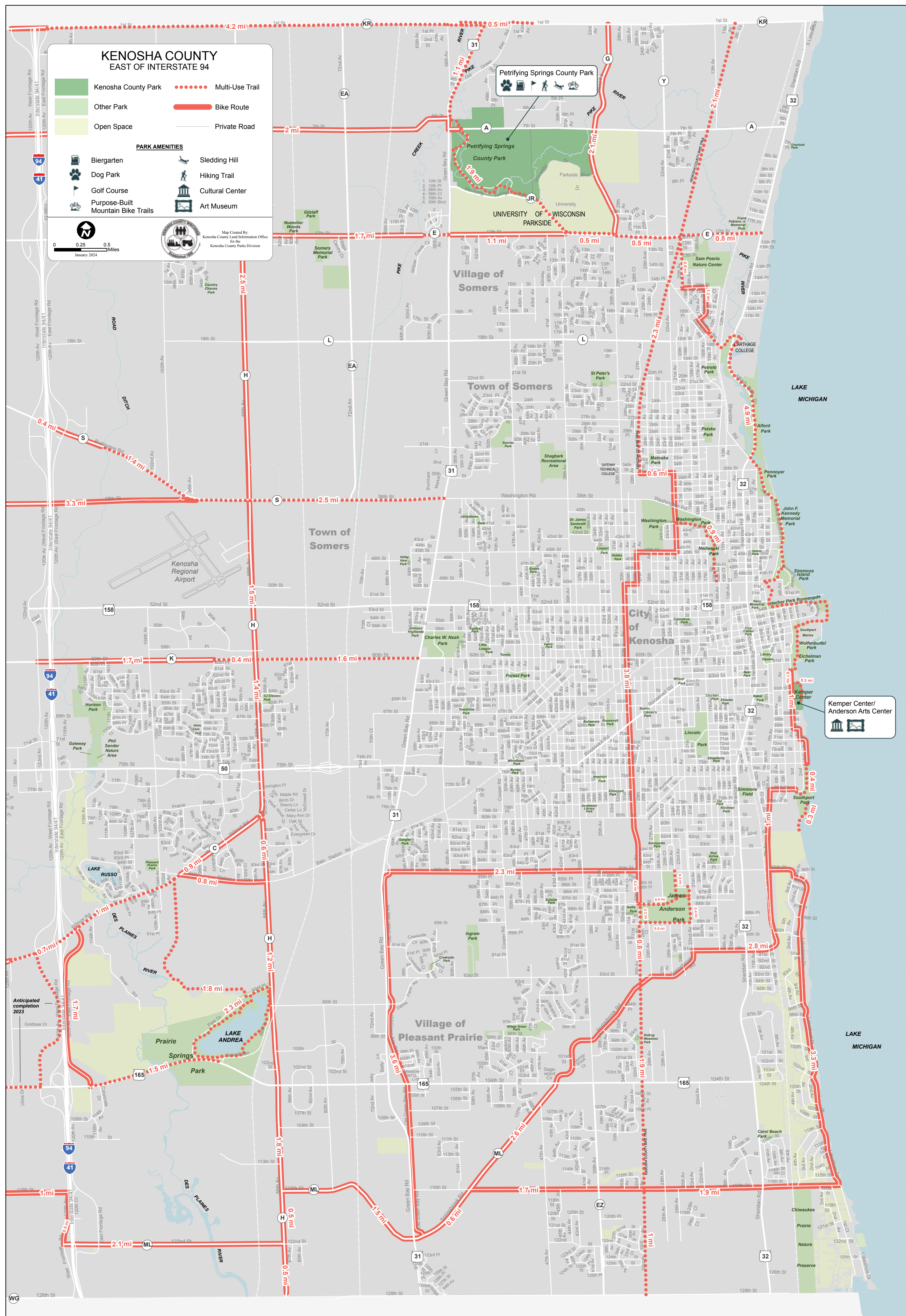

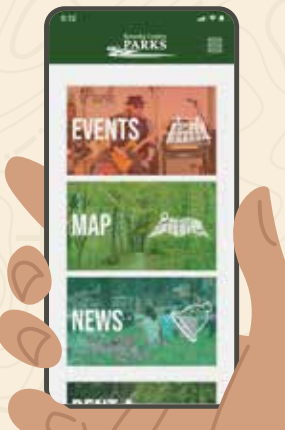

The Biergarten is a local hotspot known for its summer concert series, Bavarian pretzels, bonfires and a range of imported and local beer.

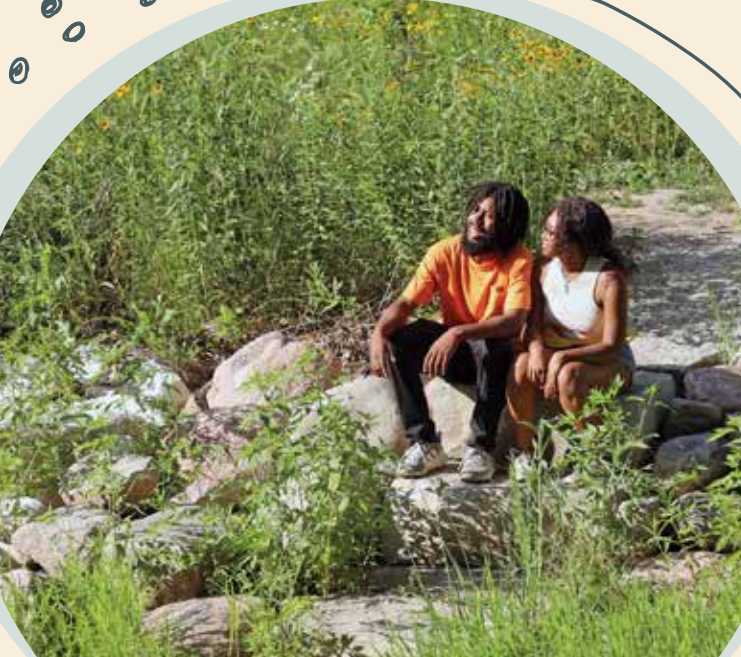

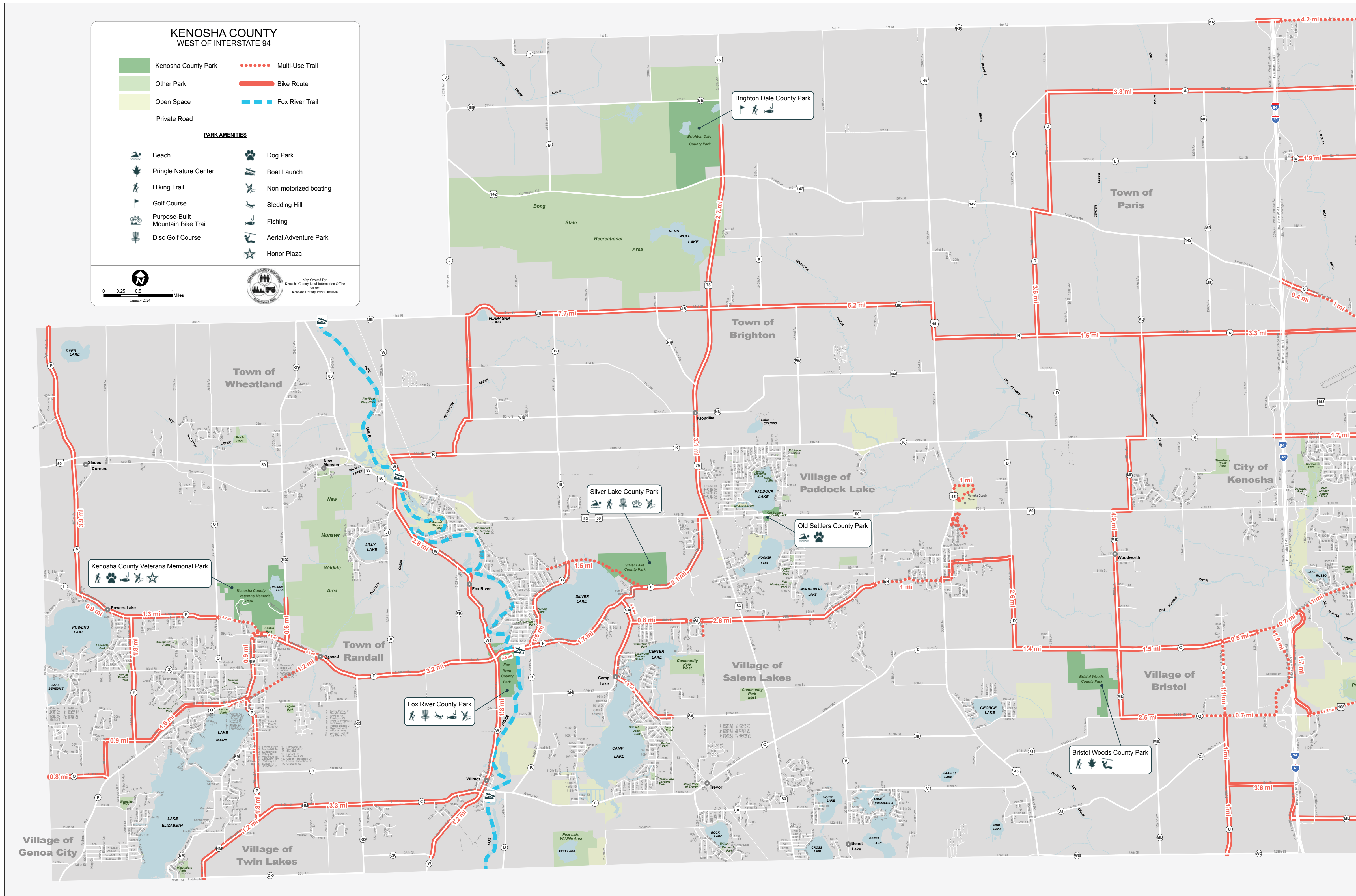
