

MEDICAL EQUIPMENT LOAN CLOSETS

You may be able to borrow medical equipment from an area ***Equipment Loan Closet***, if your insurance does not cover a certain item, or just need it for a visiting friend or family member. You may also want to donate equipment you no longer need to a loan closet. It is a good way to help others and put the equipment to good use.

Typical items available are: wheelchairs, walkers, canes, commodes, bath benches, bed tables, etc. ** It's important to know that if you have Medicare, items may be covered under Medicare, and you can check the Medicare website to search for covered equipment and local vendors: <https://www.medicare.gov/medical-equipment-suppliers/>

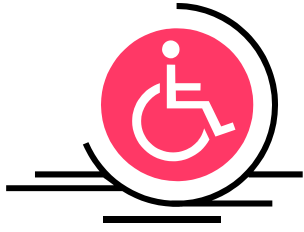
