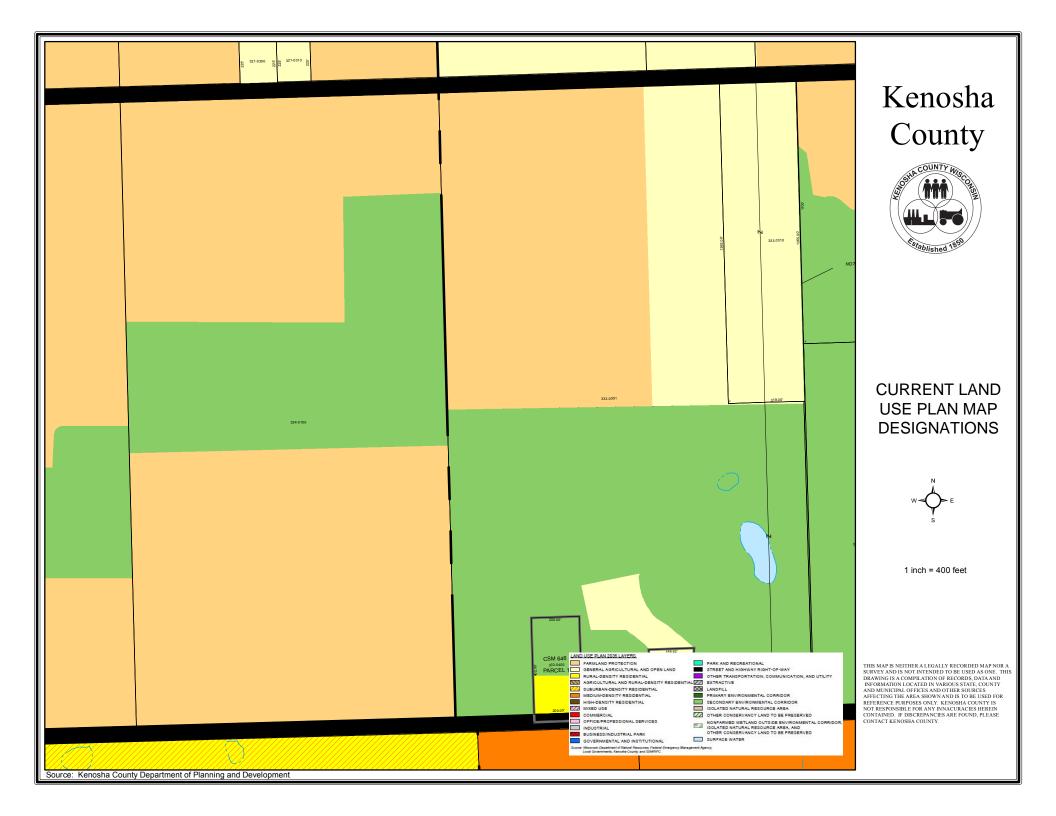


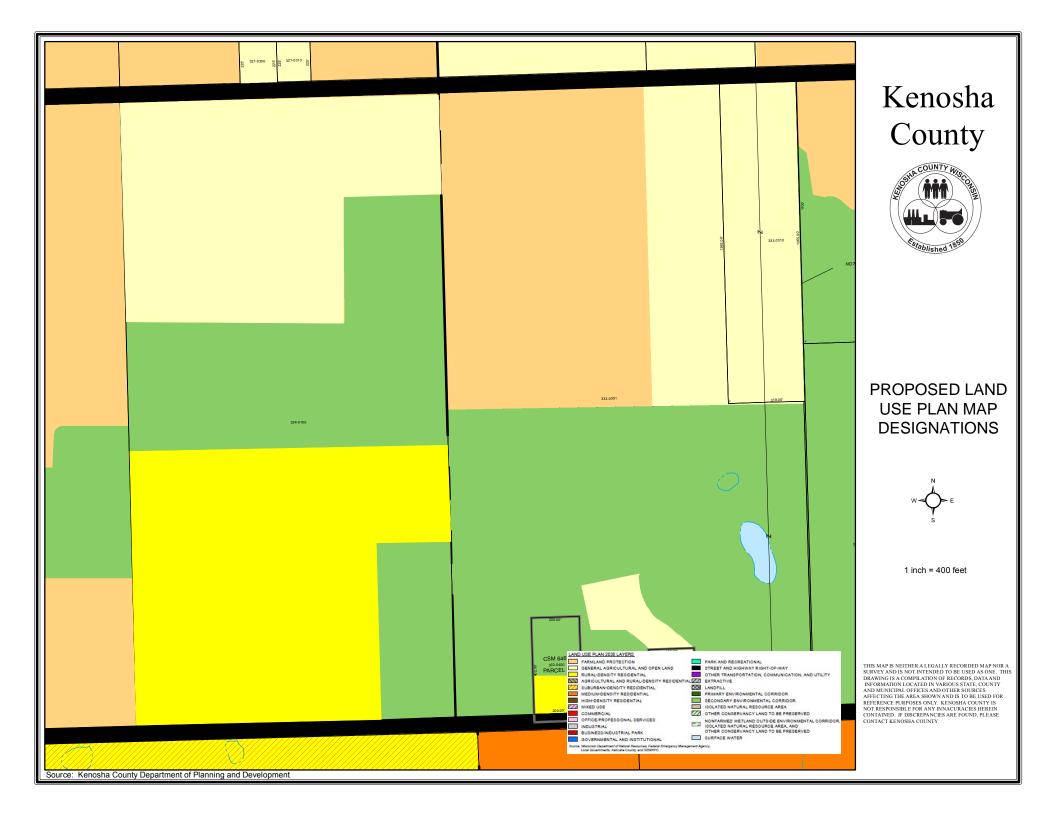
SUBJECT PROPERTY -SHOWING PLANNED DIVISIONS



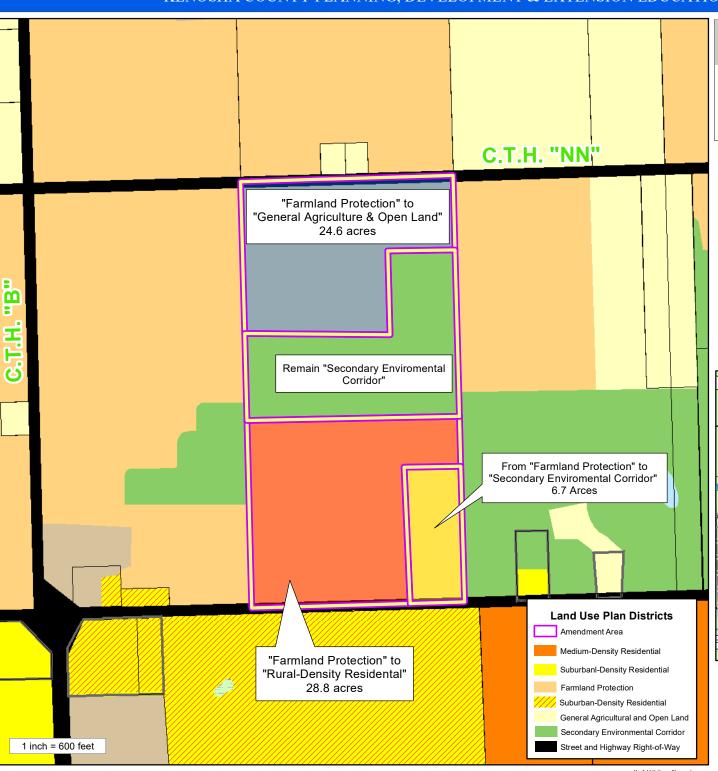

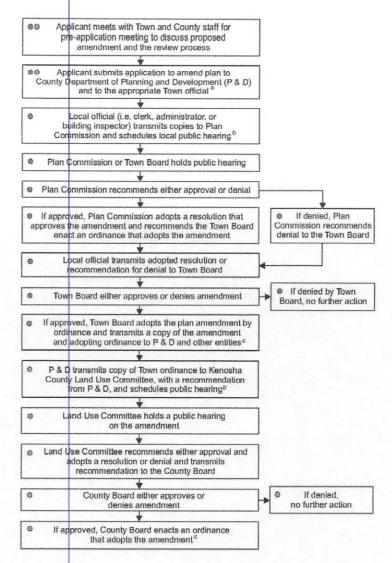

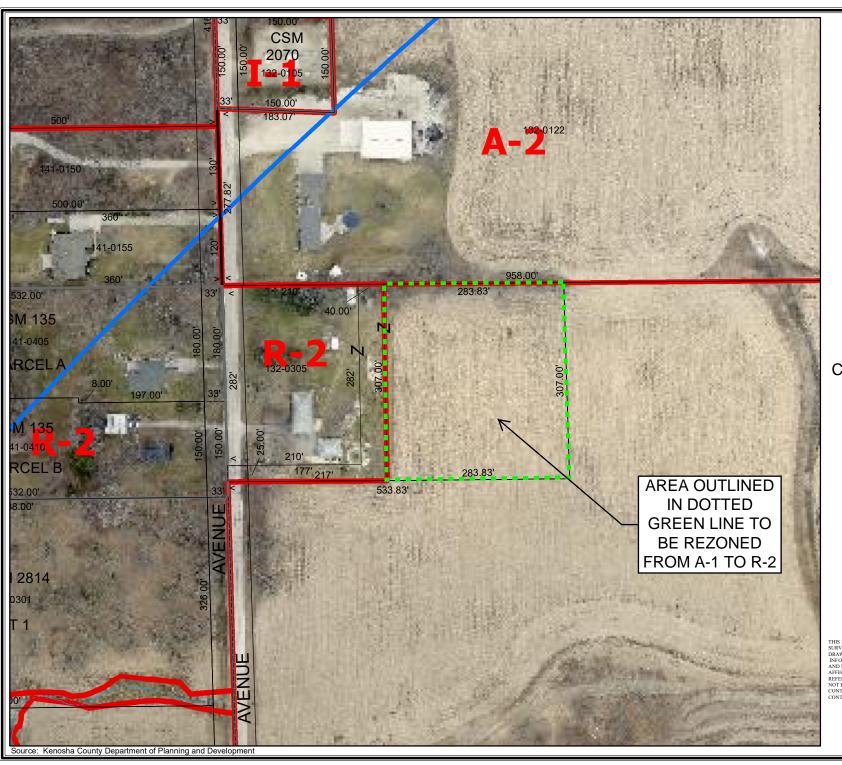

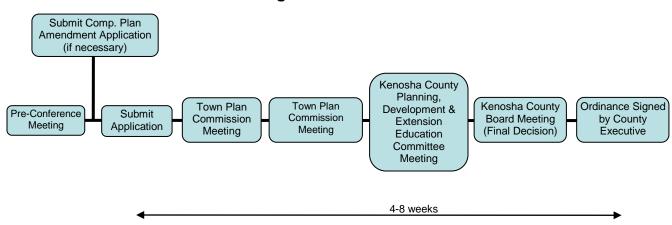
