WHEREAS, the proposed Grant, as provided by the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, stipulates that funds are to be allocated to the CITY, and COUNTY, and that the award be approved and accepted by the respective governing bodies; and

WHEREAS, the CITY, and COUNTY, find the acceptance of the 2020 Solicited Law Enforcement Grant in the amount of \$1,000,000.00 and the allocation of Grant funds to be in the public interest and best interest of all parties.

WITNESSETH:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual undertakings and agreements herein set forth, CITY, and COUNTY agree as follows:

SECTION I

CITY agrees to pay COUNTY a total lump sum of Four Hundred Thousand (\$400,000.00) Dollars of these solicited funds. The division of these funds between the City and the County is consistent with other grant awards and programs such as the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program ("JAG" Program) administered through the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs.

SECTION II

CITY agrees to use the total sum of Six Hundred Thousand (\$600,000) of Solicited Law Enforcement funds for the City of Kenosha Law Enforcement Programs and reimbursement of unbudgeted expenses for the period of August 1, 2020 to July 31, 2021. COUNTY agrees to use a total sum of Four Hundred Thousand (\$400,000) Dollars of Solicited Law Enforcement funds for the Kenosha County Law Enforcement Programs and reimbursement of unbudgeted expenses for the period of August 1, 2020 to July 31, 2021.

SECTION III

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against COUNTY other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

SECTION IV

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against the CITY other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

SECTION V

CITY and COUNTY will be responsible for their own actions in providing services under this Agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by the other party.

SECTION VI

The parties to this Agreement do not intend for any third party to obtain a right by virtue of this Agreement.

SECTION VII

The CITY and COUNTY each agree to comply with any reporting requirements of the Solicited Law Enforcement Assistance Grant and to comply with all state and federal laws, rules and regulations and program policies applicable to this Grant. By entering into this Agreement, CITY, and COUNTY do not intend to create any obligations, express, or implied, other than those set forth herein. Further, this Agreement shall not create any rights in any party not a signatory hereto.

SECTION VIII

CITY and COUNTY certify that they have authority under their respective organizational structure and governing laws to accept the Solicited Law Enforcement Assistance Grant and execute this Agreement. This Agreement was approved by the Common Council of CITY at a duly noticed and convened meeting held on the _____ day of _____, 2021. WHEREAS, Kenosha County created a comprehensive restoration plan for the Pike River within Petrifying Springs Park consisting of three major phases, and

WHEREAS, these improvements were part of the overall master plan to improve Kenosha County Veterans Memorial Park; and

WHEREAS, the overall master plan includes adding improvements to provide recreational amenities to the residents of Kenosha County; and

WHEREAS, WDNR Stewardship grant funding is available to fund the construction of a multiuse trail network and restroom facility in Kenosha County Veterans Memorial Park; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of the project is \$750,000, of which one half or \$375,000 will be Kenosha County match; and

WHEREAS, if Kenosha County receives the grant, the source of the County match will be included within the proposed 2022 County budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Kenosha County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Parks to act on its behalf to submit an application to the WDNR for a Stewardship Grant, sign documents and take necessary action to undertake, direct and complete the submission of the grant application for these projects.

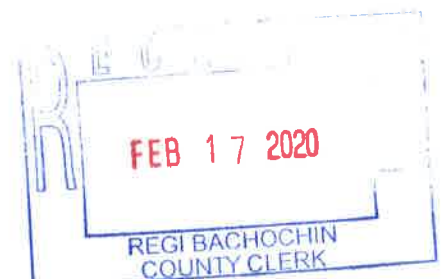
