This firm represents Julie Moore regarding civil claims arising out of a felony traffic stop executed by the Tomah Police Department on or around 1/12/22. Please direct all communication to my attention.

I write to provide you with notice pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 893.80.

On the date of the incident, Ms. Moore was stopped by Tomah officers because the Enterprise rental vehicle she was driving for work, Texas License Plate had been reported as stolen prior to her renting the vehicle, and that status had not been changed prior to Enterprise renting the vehicle to her.

Enterprise, through its authorized representative Kathryn Lang, has informed me that some fault for this incident lies with "Kenosha," although she did not specify county vs. city, and I have not yet been provided with documentation or other evidence regarding the involvement of "Kenosha."

INITIAL INFORMATION

On Wednesday, January 12th, 2022 at approximately 0534 hours I was on duty as a patrol sergeant for the City of Tomah Police Department. Officer Brueggeman informed me that he was traveling behind a vehicle that he believed was reported stolen. Officer Grimm and I responded to Officer Brueggeman's location where he was traveling south on Sime Avenue. Officer Brueggeman entered the vehicle's license plate information in to his mobile data computer. Officer Brueggeman received information that the license plate information was reported stolen. The vehicle was a 2021 black Chevrolet Malibu bearing Texas license plate

I instructed Officer Brueggeman to conduct a high risk traffic stop near TORO as the vehicle pulled in to the parking lot. Once Officer Brueggeman activated his emergency lights Officer Grimm and I positioned our vehicles correctly for a high risk traffic stop. Based on the vehicle being reported stolen and the inherent danger when dealing with stolen vehicle a high risk stop was appropriate. I pointed my duty weapon at the driver while Officer Brueggeman gave the driver commands to exit the vehicle. The driver, Julie L. Moore, was removed from the vehicle and secured in handcuffs.

Julie was informed that the vehicle was reported stolen. Julie advised officers that the car was a rental car. Julie advised that she just recently rented the car leading officers to believe that there may have been an error on the part of the rental company. The Monroe County Communications Center (MCCC) started contacting agencies in Texas in an attempt to verify the vehicle's stolen status. As the probability of the vehicle being stolen lessoned I felt it was appropriate to allow Julie to attend a meeting at TORO for her occupation. Julie was released from handcuffs. Julie parked the vehicle and continued on to her meeting. MCCC continued working to verify the vehicle's status. At 0640 MCCC was eventually able to contact an agency in Texas that stated there was an error on the part of Texas DMV. The vehicle had been reported stolen at one time. When the vehicle was returned to the rightful owner the vehicle was never cleared of its stolen status.

Julie was released with the vehicle and officers cleared from the scene.

INITIAL INFORMATION

On 1-12-2022, I was on duty as a uniformed officer for the City of Tomah Police Department. I was driving south on N Superior Ave near Baun St when I ran the Texas plate, **Section** In reading the plate return, I observed that in the vehicle section, the plate was listed as stolen, and to contact the reporting agency to verify the information. I did not however, locate an NCIC entry also listing the vehicle as stolen. Finding this information odd and contradicting, I provided the plate to Monroe County Communications Center for further clarification.

Sgt Paulson radioed me for my location, and we began coordinating our response. Officer Grimm shortly arrived behind me while the suspect vehicle was still mobile. Sgt Paulson and I planned to allow the vehicle to continue driving while MCCC attempted to verify the stolen vehicle information. We also agreed that if the vehicle pulled into a business, a high-risk traffic stop would be conducted.

Eventually the vehicle led us heading south on Sime Ave, and proceeded to turn into Toro, 200 Sime Ave. Acting on our earlier agreement, a high-risk traffic stop was conducted in the entrance to the parking lot at Toro. Upon initiating the traffic stop, I observed a Monroe County Sheriff's Office Deputy had joined us as well as two Wisconsin State Patrol Troopers, all I am assuming overhead the possible stolen vehicle information being put over the police radio, and responded to our location.

As the vehicle turned into Toro parking lot, I initiated my emergency lights, and Officer Grimm positioned his squad car near mine, setting up a high-risk traffic stop. I un-holstered my duty pistol, and began to attempt communications with the still unknown driver of the vehicle. I did not point my duty pistol at the suspect vehicle or driver. After several attempts at giving the driver commands, I believed the driver of the vehicle could possibly not hear me. I re-holstered my duty pistol and entered back into my squad car to attempt communication using the PA system in the car. Using the PA system, the driver began complying with my orders. The driver followed commands, and was safely secured in handcuffs near our squad cars.

Sgt Paulson asked the female driver if the car was a rental car, and she advised it was. The vehicle was secured, and we went back and spoke further with the female. I asked the female if she had an ID, and she advised she did, that it was in her purse. I asked the female is she minded if I searched her purse to find the wallet and she gave consent. I located her drivers license and she was

identified as Julie Moore. Julie commented "I wished you would have pulled me over down the road and not in my work." I tried explaining to her that we were attempting to wait on confirmation from Texas as to wether or not the vehicle was actually stolen or not. I asked Julie when she had rented the car, and she advised it was Sunday night, in Madison.

Julie was then removed from handcuffs, due to officers realizing this was likely not a criminal interaction. I explained to her that this was likely a big misunderstanding, however we still needed to go through our procedures to ensure everyone's safety. Julie agreed saying that she understood. I asked Julie if she had any questions I could possibly explain to her, and she advised she did not. Julie was released from the scene, despite not having heard back from Texas regarding the status of the stolen vehicle. Officers then cleared the scene.

Officers later were advised that the vehicle was no longer stolen, and the remark had not yet been removed from the system.

DISPOSITION

A high-risk traffic stop was conducted due to a "stolen vehicle" remark in the vehicle return. Driver was released due to it being an error from the issuing agency, with no nefarious activity.

INFORMATION

The vehicle return, that indicates officers had information at the time of the stop that the vehicle was reported stolen, has been added to the case. Julie also made comments during the stop indicating she wished officers had pulled her over down the road and not at her place of employment. The high risk stop was conducted in the front entrance to TORO just off of Sime Avenue. During this time of the day Sime Avenue has very heavy vehicle traffic from people traveling to and from work. The high risk stop was conducted in the TORO parking lot and not on a busy street for officer and subject safety reasons. Conducting the high risk stop in the parking lot allowed officers to safely execute the traffic stop at a location that wasn't congested with vehicle traffic.

SUMMARY:

On January 12,2022 at approximately 5:34a.m., I heard Officer A. Brueggeman communicate a license plate to Dispatch which he believed to belong to a stolen vehicle. Command staff advised to conduct a high risk traffic stop on the vehicle if the stolen status was verified or if the vehicle arrived at a business. This possibility of action was advised for the greater safety of the public within the City of Tomah. I assisted in a high risk traffic stop once the vehicle arrived into a heavily trafficked parking lot located at TORO (200 Sime Avenue). The operator was identified and later released without incident. See other officers involved reports for further information. No further follow-up is anticipated in this case.

ACTION TAKEN:

Upon hearing the Officer A. Brueggeman request for confirmation on a potentially stolen vehicle, I began to drive towards his location. I did so because due to my training and experience, I was aware, if the vehicle were confirmed as stolen, a high risk traffic stop would be conducted, which required a minimum of two police vehicles in order to be conducted as trained.

I informed Officer A. Brueggeman of my awareness of the ongoing records check via Dispatch, and of my arrival to his location. I convened with Officer A. Brueggeman while he was following the potentially stolen vehicle while both were performing an eastbound turn onto Townline Road from N. Glendale Avenue. Sgt. C. Paulson advised, since the vehicle was coming to a highly trafficked area of the City of Tomah, if Dispatch had not received a confirmation of the status of the vehicle prior to the vehicle parking at a business, a high risk traffic stop was to be conducted for the safety of the greater public in the City of Tomah.

Dispatch was unable to receive the status of the vehicle, and the status remained unknown as the vehicle conducted another eastbound turn from the 200 block of Sime Avenue into the parking lot of TORO. Per the orders from command staff, a high risk traffic stop was conducted.

During the stop, I utilized my service rifle and pointed it at the suspect vehicle. I only issued commands when the operator attempted to exit the vehicle from the driver's side door prior to instruction. The operator was then given commands to exit the vehicle by Officer A. Brueggeman and was placed into handcuffs without incident. I then assisted in clearing the vehicle of other threats/ hazards. See other officers involved reports for further information regarding their actions.

I immediately stopped the car, not knowing why suddenly there were 3-4 police cars with lights and sirens blaring. Thinking they were there for an incident at the plant, J pulled to the side of the drive to allow them to go around me- not realizing I was the one they were there for. I could not hear them on their speakers as my windows were up, still not knowing what was happening.

I was expecting someone to walk up but when they weren't, I started to open my door at which time I was then able to hear them on their speakers yell at me to stay in the car. I, of course complied, and then rolled down the window so that I could hear. They instructed me to throw the keys out of the window, then get out of the car, then walk back to them and they proceed to put me in handcuffs. I won't go through every single detail as I have it on video from our company's security cameras.

The officers asked me who I was etc. and then told me the car was reported stolen, but they were still waiting on confirmation for something. I allowed them to get my ID out of my wallet at which time the officer said "oh you're from Ohio" seemingly very disappointed. Two officers continued to detain me and ask questions while still in handcuff, while three officers approached my car in a tactical formation with guns drawn and searched the car.

I understand that they have a job to do, however, my concern is the excessiveness of this incident. When I viewed the video, you could clearly see at least six police cars (it actually looks like eight) and a full line up of officers with guns and rifles pointed at me from behind their vehicles. I believe the officer that followed me from my hotel was watching for my car to leave the Hampton parking lot as he was behind me within seconds of me leaving the Hampton. He most likely could have seen me (5' tall small framed older female) walk across the parking lot alone to get to my car.

Later that evening when a coworker of mine asked Sgt Corcoran about the incident he stated he didn't even know there was an incident that morning, but he would look into it and review the body cam. My video looks like the two officers that had me in handcuffs also had guns on me even when they knew I was of no threat to them or anyone else.

In addition to the excessiveness of the situation, towards the end of this, I could hear the officers present chuckle about it and that "She is the HR Manager". When the officers decided they were done, they handed me the keys and said I could move the car, but gave me no further information. I was not even sure if I was ok to go into the building, if they needed any other information or was going to have any further information for me. I am still traumatized by the magnitude of what occurred.

I requested a copy of the police report on Friday before I left to come home but was told that it was not completed yet. I find that disturbing as well considering the entire department was there and it was being called "a high-risk situation at The Toro Company" on the scanner.

I would like to have a copy of the report sent to me at this email when it is completed.


