WHEREAS, the Southeastern Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission (SEWRPC) has identified 172-acres of ecologically sensitive areas critical to the ecosystem of Kenosha County; and

WHEREAS, Kenosha County wishes to work cooperatively with UW-Parkside to plan and implement land management surveys and improvements to strengthen the health of natural areas; and

WHEREAS, Kenosha County has a 50-year Land Use Agreement with UW-Parkside to develop ecological and recreational improvements within Petrifying Springs Park and UW-Parkside natural areas; and

WHEREAS, a project has been identified that will produce a natural resource inventory plan and associated restoration initiatives focusing on these ecologically sensitive areas within Petrifying Springs Park and UW-Parkside land; and

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of the project shall not exceed \$50,000, and

WHEREAS, a Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) Urban Forestry grant is available to Kenosha County that will fund \$25,000 of the project, and

WHEREAS, there are funds available in the Kenosha County Parks budget to pay for the remaining \$25,000 of project cost and no additional borrowing or levy dollars are needed,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Kenosha County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Parks to act on its behalf to submit an application to the WDNR for an Urban Forestry grant, sign documents, accept grant award, and take necessary action to undertake, direct and complete the approved project.
