WHEREAS, the 117th US Congress passed the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, a \$1.9 trillion economic stimulus bill, and President Biden signed this act into law on March 11, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Kenosha County has been identified as being apportioned approximately \$32.89 million in the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Treasury has opened the Submission Portal from which Kenosha County can request the first tranche which is expected to be fifty percent of the total apportionment; and

WHEREAS, the second tranche will be available after twelve months following the date of the receipt of the first tranche; and

WHEREAS, these American Rescue Plan funds are allowed to be expended from March 3, 2021 to December 31, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Administration will review the allowed uses of this funding when it becomes available, develop a plan to expend this funding, and bring this plan and any related budget modification to the County Board of Supervisors for approval;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Kenosha County Board of Supervisors approve the acceptance of both tranches of American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 funding and authorize the Administration to submit the applications to receive this funding as soon as it is able.
