THE KENOSHA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN that
Municipal Code of Kenosha County Chapter 2.05 (3), the
County Board Rules of Procedure, is hereby amended as
follows:

3) Committee Assignments.

- (a) Standing Committees of the County Board may at the discretion of the Board Chair consist of five (5) or seven (7) members except that the Finance and Administration Committee must have seven (7) members.
- (b) Every supervisor shall serve on at least one committee.
- (c) No supervisor shall serve on more than three standing committees.
- (d) No chairman of another standing committee may serve on the Finance and Administration Committee.
- (e) The Finance and Administration Committee Chairman may not serve on any other standing committee except the Executive Committee.
- (f) No more than two members from any one standing committee may serve on the Finance and Administration Committee.
- (g) The Executive Committee shall consist of the Board Chair, Vice-Chair and each Committee Chair. In the event the Vice Chair is also a Committee Chair, the Chair of the Board shall appoint another Supervisor of his or her choosing.
- (h) No supervisor shall simultaneously serve as the chair of a standing committee and as the chair of more than one other a County affiliated board, committee, or

commission. "Affiliated" shall be defined as a board, committee, or commission in which all appointments are made by the County Executive, the County Board Chair, or a combination of the two. It shall not apply to any body which is, or acts on behalf of, an entity legally separate from Kenosha County. Further, this provision shall not be interpreted to in any way restrict the ability of the County Board Chair to appoint a temporary, time or task limited, or otherwise special committee of the County Board and to appoint any supervisor of his or her choosing to chair it, regardless of whether that supervisor is already chairing a standing committee or affiliated board, committee, or commission.

- (i) The provisions of sections 2.05(3)(a) and 2.05 (3)(c) shall not apply to the Executive Committee.
