The meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m. by Chairman Gaschke.

1. Ordinance Extending The Previously Enacted Moratorium On Consideration and/or Issuance Of Zoning Permits, Certificates Of Compliance, Site Plan Review And Zoning Approvals For Adult Entertainment Establishments For A Period Of 90 Days

Corporation Counsel Joseph Cardamone presented this information regarding a 90 day moratorium in relation to adult entertainment establishments.

Maurer/Rodriguez motion to <u>approve</u> and recommend to the Kenosha County Board of Supervisors the 90 day moratorium ordinance as presented. Passed unanimously, including YIG.

Supervisor Nudo noted the County Board meeting would be starting soon and suggested placing agenda item #2 on the next regular meeting agenda since this meeting started late.

Supervisor Nudo made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion failed for lack of a second.

Chairman Gaschke noted the Committee members had previously received the information for the following item and noted it was a time sensitive issue. He called for a brief discussion or a motion on the item.

- 2. Youth In Governance Discussion of Candidates to Recommend for Appointment This item is regarding the Youth In Governance interview scores for the 2020-2021 candidate selection. Supervisor Nudo noted he would be abstaining from voting on this item.
 - ➤ Rodriguez/Maurer motion to <u>approve</u> and recommend to the Kenosha County Board of Supervisors the Youth In Governance appointments as presented. Passed on a 4-0 voice vote, including YIG, with Supervisor Nudo abstaining.

Supervisor Maurer made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Rodriguez and passed unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 7:31p.m.
