Kenosha County to host “Fall Wheel Ride”

Kenosha County Executive Jim Kreuser invites bike riders of all ability levels to participate in the Third Annual Fall Wheel Ride to Petrifying Springs Park from 10 a.m. to Noon on Saturday, Sept. 29th.

“This is a great event for families to bike together and it is also a wonderful opportunity to enjoy fall in Kenosha County,” Kreuser said.

Riders are encouraged to select one of three starting points at a time convenient for them for the self-guided ride to the park’s Pavilion 1, located near the Highway JR entrance. The routes will be marked by fall leaf motif painted on the pavement. The three suggested self-starting points are:

- Simmons Island Park, 44th Street and Kennedy Drive. – 5.8 miles (one way) to Pavilion 1 at Petrifying Springs Park;
- Bose Elementary School, 1900 15th St. – 2.3 miles to Pavilion 1 at Petrifying Springs Park; and
- Family Fun Ride at Petrifying Springs Park, 761 Green Bay Road – 1.1 miles from Pavilion 1 at Petrifying Springs Park up the Hill Road to the Golf Course and back.

Apple cider, popcorn and water will be provided for riders by the Kenosha County Parks Department.
