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CCS (Comprehensive Community Services)

We continue to review service arrays within CCS. The previous Medicaid Newsletters addressed Screening and Assessment, Service Planning and Service Facilitation, Diagnostic Evaluations, Medication Management, Physical Health Monitoring and Peer Support. The next service array to be highlighted is Individual Skill Development and Enhancement.



Individual Skill Development and Enhancement (sometimes referred to as ISDE) services include training in:

- Communication
- Interpersonal Skills
- Problem Solving
- Decision-making
- Self-regulation
- Conflict Resolution

- Other specified needs identified in the member's service plan



Services also include training in daily living skills related to:

- Personal Care
- Household Tasks
- Financial management
- Transportation
- Shopping
- Parenting
- Assessing and connecting to community resources and services (including health care services)
- Other specific daily living needs identified in the member's service plan

Services provided to minors should also focus on improving integration into and interaction with the minor's family, school, community and other social networks.



Services include assisting the minor's family in gaining skills to assist the minor with individual skill development and enhancement. Services that are designed to support the family MUST be directly related to the assessed needs of the minor. Services may be provided individually or in a group setting.

Skill training may be provided by various methods, including, but not limited to:

- Modeling
- Monitoring
- Mentoring
- Supervision
- Assistance
- Cuing
