Sharmain worked with the Racine/Kenosha Community Action Agency (WIC office) running their Fatherhood Program and is connected with many other community organizations. 	Bylaws Update These had not been updated since 1996 so the goal was to align them with current state statute along with modernizing them, bringing in health equity and social determinants of health. These will be reviewed at the County Board meeting on Sept. 15 th . We have one other vacancy that we cannot fill until the bylaws are passed. Currently at 8 members. Focus in 2021 will be orientation for new members and strategic visioning, looking at new mission, vision, goals and objectives. COVID Update	
	Positive cases are still relatively low. Hiring 8 Disease Investigators and 6 Contact Tracers. There are new	

	flexible guidelines from the State Epidemiologist (mitigation model).	
	All schools are on an amended surveillance system and hoping to track better data with this.	
	Gearing up for the end of September by rewriting some of our processes and plans. Providing schools with

	consistent basis to see where the virus is moving within the county.
