## White House Presentation Notes and Links 7:00 PM

David Agnew Deputy Director of the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs

- 1. Does not work with Congress or Senate.
- 2. Office of Intergovernmental Affairs is used by the White House to communicate and reach out directly to state and local governments.
- 3. Host several types of briefings: lectures; panel discussions; demonstrations; round table discussions; focus groups (briefing for county officials); and conference calls.
- 4. Have staff working within every single agency

Austin Goolsbee Chairman of White House Counsel of Economic Advisors

- 1. 20% expansion in economy mostly in Healthcare, Education and Manufacturing this year.
- 2. 2+ million jobs added in the private sector this year.
- 3. -300,000 state and local jobs lost this year.
- 4. Public Sector jobs lag 6-12 months behind the rest of the economy.
- 5. Importance of closing trade deficit
- 6. Emphasized research and development and small business expansion is necessary for sustained economic growth.
- 7. Congress federal budget deficit and debt
- 8. Highlighted the removal of the Pell Grant Program from the congressional budget proposal. "Removing financial aid for higher education would lead to 100,000-200,000 people dropping out of school. People with college degrees make 10% more throughout their lifetime we can't afford to have people make less."
- 9. Don't count on a second stimulus.
- 10. President Obama does not support extending high income tax credits in 2012.

Stephanie Cutter Deputy Senior Advisor to the President (focused on messaging)

- 1. Administration's goal is to change the way Washington talks about the economy. "People don't talk about economy in Consumer Price Index or Gross Domestic Product. They talk about it in terms of what they can afford." Then she proceeded to talk Washington speak.
- 2. V.P. Biden in charge of a special commission charged with cutting waste out of the federal budget

- 3. Question was asked about ongoing situation with the National Labor Relations Board and Boeing. White House supports both labor and business. White House helped secure two large trade deals for Boeing with China and India
- 4. Question about White House treats rural communities. Tom Villasack Secretary of Agriculture leads a task force on addressing rural issues

Heather Zical Deputy Assistant to the President Office of Energy and Climate Change

- 1. (Slide 22) Next month White House will do something never before in American history by unveiling new fuel efficiency standards for trucks.
- 2. They are currently in progress of developing new fuel efficiency standards for cars for the years 2012-2017.
- 3. The White House has a goal of putting 1 million electric vehicles on the road by 2015.
- 4. (Slide 23) New green building program called Green to Gold. \$100 Million in the Federal Budget (we don't have a budget yet) to help states and localities develop green building standards.

White House set a goal of increasing energy efficiency 20% for commercial buildings by the year 2020.
