Real Estate Records:

While the office is closed to the public, we will continue to process documents submitted either electronically or through the mail. Kenosha county has scanned all of its Real Estate Records with the exception of a drawer of resolutions. We are fully indexed 40 years, and all of our indexes are available through Landshark to search. Once the document number, and/or volume and page is found it can be obtained through Landshark. As far as the resolutions go, if one is needed simply email my deputy Jennifer Mack (Jennifer.Mack@kenoshacounty.org) and we will scan the document in to make it available on Landshark.

Vital Records:
