Project Update

- Gas main relocation nearing completion for Phase I and II.
- Communication lines installed through Phase 1 nearing completion.
- Underground utility relocations along County Highway H nearing completion.
- Underground relocation of fiber optic communication lines along Canadian Pacific Railway has been completed.
- Stage 1A traffic with crossover at Brumback Boulevard and lane shift at County Highway H complete.
- Pile driving and pier construction underway for County Highway S bridge over Canadian Pacific Railway.
- New alignment of County Highway EA is complete and open to traffic.
- Storm sewer and pipe culvert installations ongoing along the new westbound lanes between Canadian Pacific Railway and County Highway EA, and along County Highway H, north of County Highway S.
- Frontage road grading and stone placement has been completed.

- Grading to construct embankment east and west of Canadian Pacific Railway bridge ongoing.
- Ditch cuts and topsoil placement nearing completion between 84th Avenue and County Highway EA.
- Regional Stormwater pond excavation ongoing.
