

COUNTY HIGHWAY SEAST FRONTAGE ROAD TO WIS 31

Project Update

July 2, 2021



Kenosha County, in partnership with Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), is underway with reconstructing County Highway S from the Interstate 94 East Frontage Road to WIS 31, with scheduled completion in late fall 2021.


WORK COMPLETED TO DATE:

- Westbound lanes have been constructed and lower lifts of asphalt have been placed
- Box culvert extension and new wingwalls constructed on both sides of the Pike River crossing
- New bridge constructed over Canadian Pacific Railway
- New bridge constructed over Kilbourn Ditch
- New at-grade crossing constructed at Union Pacific Railway
- · Grading and base aggregate for multi-use path
- County Highway H widening has been completed with asphalt placed
- Grading work on eastbound lanes has been completed

WORK REMAINING:

- Complete final storm sewer installations near 84th Avenue
- Complete areas of grading west of Union Pacific Railway
- Complete curb and gutter from Union Pacific Railway east to Brumback Boulevard
- · Complete median work at Brumback Boulevard
- Asphalt paving eastbound lanes from County Highway H to Brumback Boulevard
- · Asphalt paving remaining gaps in multi-use path
- Signalized intersections at Amazon, County Highway H, and Brumback Boulevard
- Pedestrian signals at WIS 31 (Green Bay Road)
- · Asphalt paving surface lift throughout the project
