Public Works/Facilities Committee Parks Division Status Report for September, 2021

- Kenosha County Veterans Memorial Park:
 - **Phase I:** Contractor(s) have substantially completed the honor plaza concrete, flag walk wall, and grading. Work is progressing with landscaping, site furnishings, paving, and striping. Project is schedule to be completed in early October.
 - **Phase II:** See attached draft concepts for Phase II restroom pavilion and memorial shelters.
- Pike River Restoration (Phase II) and Pedestrian Bridge Replacement: Phase II construction was substantially completed on September 3rd. (see attached project photos).
- Petrifying Springs Park & UW-Parkside Comprehensive Trail Plan: Work is ongoing with the creation of 3.4 miles of multiuse hiking trails per the master plan. 

 - Removed brush and seed UW-Extension garden area




