Public Works/Facilities Committee Parks Division Status Report for February, 2022

- ***Petrifying Springs Park Playground #4:*** Bids are due on 2/16/22 for the construction of the new area #4 playground. Construction anticipated to begin in early spring and be completed by the end of June, 2022.
- ***Petrifying Springs Park & UW-Parkside Multiuse Trails:*** Bids are due on 2/17/22 for the installation of the helical piles and the fabrication of four pedestrian bridges. Installation of the prefabricated bridges will be completed by park staff during the 2022 construction season.
- ***Seasonal Recruitment:*** Seasonal positions are now open for lifeguards, beach manager, assistant beach manager, fee collectors, short-term maintenance and long-term maintenance. Park staff is actively recruiting for seasonal positions at local high-schools and universities.
- ***South Bike Trail:*** Three culverts along the south bike trail will be replaced between January – February, 2022 to aid in the storm water management plan. Park staff is continuing with brush and tree removals along the South Bike Trail as weather allows.
- ***Multijurisdictional/Interstate Multiuse Trail Collaboration:*** Thelen Sand and Gravel and Kenosha County have been engaged in discussions to expand a 4-mile off-road multiuse trail on Thelen Sand and Gravel property to connect existing and future multiuse trails within northern IL to Southeast WI.
