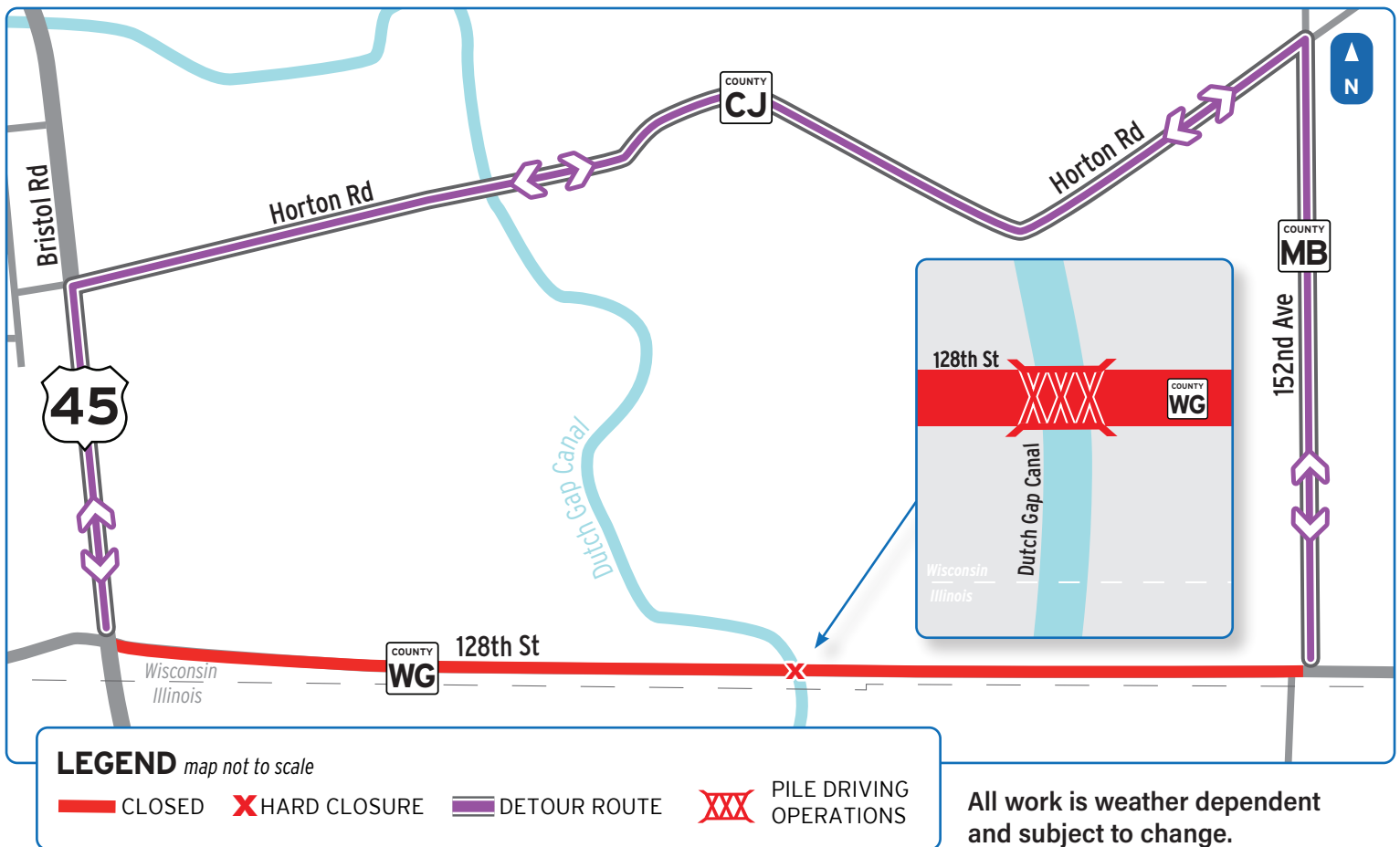
Week of March 21:

- Daytime pile driving operations on County Highway WG (128th Street) at the Dutch Gap Canal, are scheduled to begin Monday, March 21 for approximately two weeks.

Businesses and residents should be aware that there will be noise and dust associated with this work, steps will be taken to minimize these effects.

→ Detour Route:

Motorists are encouraged to utilize US 45 (Bristol Road), County Highway CJ (Horton Road), and County MB (152nd Avenue) to get around the closure.
