

## COUNTY HIGHWAY K YEAR-END PROJECT UPDATE

Greetings from Kenosha County and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT).

The project team has completed most of the 2022 reconstruction project on County Highway K (60th Street) by the Canadian Pacific Railroad (CPRR).

Some electrical work will be ongoing throughout the winter months, however, County Highway K will remain open throughout this time. The following work is scheduled to resume in spring 2023:

- Railroad track replacement by CPRR
- Grading, pavement, and curb and gutter at CPRR
- Railroad signal and gate replacement by CPRR
- Paving the multi-use path and sidewalk at CPRR
