

PURPOSE & NEED

The goal of the project :

- Improve intersection safety and efficiency
 - Numerous crashes
 - Majority were angle crashes caused by failure to yield, which can be mitigated with roundabout
- Roundabout advantages:
 - Less severe intersection crashes




PROJECT LIMITS

Limits: (County) Highway Y – (County) Highway A intersection

Length: Highway Y – 1,500 ft Highway A – 1,500 ft

Construction: 2023






PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Highway Y and Highway A will be closed for the duration of the project
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained




PROJECT OVERVIEW





DETOUR

- Highway A motorists are encouraged to utilize WIS 31, Highway KR, and WIS 32 to detour around closure
- Highway Y motorists are encouraged to utilize Highway E, WIS 32, and Highway KR to detour around closure
- Maintain access for EMS
- Address any through traffic within subdivision





SITE SAFETY


- Safety of the traveling public and workers is our first priority
- Encouraging the public to obey all traffic signs
- We rely on the public to report any unsafe situation within the work zone
- Dust, noise, and drainage control during construction



Motorists should obey traffic control signs and pavement markings, and drive safely through the work zone
