CTH EM Resurfacing Project From: State Line Road To: CTH Z (Wilmot Avenue) Village of Twin Lakes Kenosha County, WI

Meeting Purpose

The meeting purpose is to introduce the project to the public and explain the proposed construction impacts of the project. The existing CTH EM corridor is a narrow roadway with little to no shoulders. The road lacks lateral clearance between vehicles and pedestrians who frequently use the shoulder. The proposed project will add a widened paved shoulder for the entire length of the corridor to provide separation between vehicles and pedestrians.

The meeting will begin with a brief presentation on the project, with an information open house to follow so that attendees may stop in at their convenience and view exhibits, meet with project staff, ask questions, and provide feedback.

Project Information

CTH EM is slated to be constructed beginning in March 2023, with completion in June 2023. The project limits will begin north of State Line Road and end west of CTH Z (Wilmot Ave). The widened paved shoulder will begin on the lake side of the road at the State Line and will continue on that side for approximately 1.2 miles to the northeast. There, the widened shoulder will switch sides of the road to the side opposite the lakes and continue on that side for the remaining 1.4 miles to CTH Z (Wilmot Ave). The width of the widened shoulder will vary between 2.5 feet, 6 feet, and 9.5 feet depending upon the conditions of the surrounding terrain. A location map showing the locations of the various shoulder can be seen on the following page.

As part of the project, underground storm sewer and rectangular box chambers are proposed to improve drainage and serve as storm water detention and treatment.


Proposed Traffic Impacts

Construction is scheduled to begin in March 2023.

During construction, local traffic only will be allowed through the project work area and for access needs. There will be a marked detour for all other traffic that will consist of State Line Road, CTH HM. and CTH Z.

During working hours, there may be periods of time during which one-way traffic and temporary driveway closures will be necessary to construct the underground storm sewer. Outside working hours, the road will be open to two-way traffic and all driveways will be accessible. The County's project construction team will contact homeowners and businesses in advance prior to closing a driveway.

Construction is currently scheduled for completion in June 2023.



Real Estate

There are seven (7) properties along CTH EM from which Kenosha County proposes to acquire temporary construction easements and one (1) property from which Kenosha County proposes to acquire permanent right-of-way.

Kenosha County or its representatives will contact the property owners directly and formally to obtain agreements. In general, the easements are proposed for the purposes of drainage, while the one right-of-way acquisition is proposed to provide space to fit the widened shoulder.
