Vaccines for Children

Vaccines are one of the best ways to keep your children healthy. Kenosha County Public Health offers childhood immunizations at a low cost to you through the Vaccines for Children program.

Eligibility

Worried about the cost of vaccines for your children? Your child is eligible if they:

- are Medicaid eligible or Medicaid-enrolled
- have no health insurance
- have health insurance, but the coverage does not include any or all vaccines
- are American Indian or Alaska Native
