RECYCLE OFTEN



METAL CANS

Steel, tin & aluminum soda, vegetable, fruit & tuna cans



PLASTIC BOTTLES & CONTAINERS

Recycle by shape. All bottles, jars, jugs and tubs are most likely plastic.



PAPER

Brown paper bags, non-confidential office paper, newspaper, magazines



PAPER, CARDBOARD, DAIRY & JUICE CONTAINERS



FLATTENED CARDBOARD & PAPERBOARD



GLASS BOTTLES & JARS

RECYCLE RIGHT: Things you can do to ensure quality material is recycled



FOOD AND LIQUID WASTE ARE TO BE PLACED IN THE **NEW** BLACK FOOD AND LIQUID WASTE BARRELS.

- Make sure items are **CLEAN** before recycling. Paper and cardboard must be dry and free of food debris.
- **REMOVE** food contamination and caps from cans and plastics.
- **DO NOT** place medical waste in recycling containers.
