Recycle by shape. All bottles, jars, jugs and tubs are most likely plastic. Brown paper bags, non-confidential office paper, newspaper, magazines

RECYCLE RIGHT: Things you can do to ensure quality material is recycled



FOOD AND LIQUID WASTE ARE TO BE PLACED IN THE NEW BLACK FOOD AND LIQUID WASTE BARRELS.

- Make sure items are CLEAN before recycling. Paper and cardboard must by dry and free of food debris.
- REMOVE food contamination and caps from cans and plastics.
- DO NOT place medical waste in recycling containers.
